ADMINISTRATIVE LAW II (PPL 206)

Answer 4 (Four) Questions. Time Allowed: 2½ Hours

- 1) Mr Habib is a Taxi driver. Mr. Habib recently bought a brand new Toyota salon car. He proposed to obtain a permit to use the Cab at Aiyetoro Local Government Council Area. To this end, he paid the sum of N15,000 for the Council's permit and filled the necessary forms as stipulated under the relevant section of the Aiyetoro Local Government Council Bye-Law. Mr. Habib visited the Council last week and was informed that the Secretary to the Local Government Council, Mr. Kosiberu had refused to grant the permit on the ground that five other Taxi Drivers applied for the permit the same time with Mr. Habib. Mr. Habib had already written a letter to demand for the grant of his application for permit but Mr. Kosiberu had refused to grant the permit claiming that his decision was final. Mr. Habib is contemplating the institution of legal action against Aiyetoro Local Government Council and had come to seek your opinion on the success or otherwise of his prospective legal action. Write your opinion on the appropriate legal remedy available to Mr. Habib and the conditions required for the redress.
- 2) With the aid of decided cases, discuss the scope of the jurisdiction of Universities to discipline its students for criminal conduct.
- 3) With the assistance of both judicial and statutory authorities, discuss the grounds upon which a court of superior record will quash the decision of an administrative body or an inferior court.
- 4) Critically discuss the principles of Natural justice in the context of Administrative law and decision making by an administrator
- 5) The office of the Ombudsman is legally recognised to investigate abuse of office and maladministration in Nigeria.
 - a) Discuss the rationale for the establishment of the Ombudsman, its powers and limitations (if any)
 - b) Enumerate other non-judicial avenues available to seek redress against an administrator.
